I am a disaster management specialist with more than 15 years' experience with interests in child-centered approach. In January 2020, I have been awarded a Doctoral of Philosophy degree from Macquarie University, Australia. I also completed a Master of Research degree from the same university. I am a senior research fellow of the Resilience Development Initiative (www.rdi.or.id), General Chairperson of the Indonesian Disaster Management Society of (www.mpbi.info) and board member the Consortium for Disaster Education in Indonesia.

My working experiences include the development of the first response framework of ASEAN (ASEAN Joint Disaster Response Plan), the ASEAN Regional Contingency Plans, initiated the ASEAN Safe Schools Initiative (ASSI), and founder of PREDIKT- a toolkit for children and parents to learn disaster preparedness in a fun and interactive way. I was also supporting the Government of Indonesia on knowledge management and coordination support team in the shelter, education, WASH, and community engagement sectors.


