Markus Moke holds a PhD in Communication Sciences, International Politics and Psychology. Between 2007 and 2012 he was Director of the Joint European Master's Programme in International Humanitarian Action (NOHA Master's Programme) at University of Bochum, Germany.

As Joint Sphere Focal Point for Germany, Markus Moke is a certified Sphere trainer and CHS trainer. He edited the first German version of the Sphere Handbook on Quality Standards in International Humanitarian Aid (2011) and coordinated the second German edition of the 2018 Sphere Handbook.
